The Characteristics of a Content Christian

1 Timothy 6:6-10

❖ People don't quit when they are ahead because they are greedy

- Be content with what God has given you
- The suffering of Jesus is enough to sustain me
- We can't appreciate what we already have so why should we expect Him to give us more

❖ To be a content Christian we must: Renew an eternal perspective

- We carried nothing into the world and carry nothing out of it
- Only the things you do for Christ will last
- We are too concerned with our investment in ourselves and are not invested in the Lord
- God blesses you so you can turn around and bless someone else
- When you are content you want to give to others

❖ To be a content Christian we must: Respect God's daily provisions

- Success is not defines by what you possess, if you possess anything it should be the Holy Spirit in your heart
- Our ambition should never cause us to miss church, serving God, or spending time with our family
- He promised to supply all our needs not all our wants

❖ To be a content Christian we must: Resist Evil Pleasures
